Policies & Guidelines

- Bengali in Bangalore (BinB) is a registered socio-cultural association which conducts various socio-cultural events throughout the calendar year.
- Bengali in Bangalore respects every individual and treats them equally. BinB do not exercise any barrier of religion, socio economic background, physical appearance or ability, Gender, Age, Sexual & Political preferences, Caste or creed.
- This membership is valid for the current year (Bengali in Bangalore society follows August – July). Membership taken at any point of the year is valid till the coming 31st July. (Example: Membership taken on 12th of November, 2018 is valid till 31st July, 2019)
- Membership fee, once paid, cannot be refunded or transferred. However, the same can be cancelled, by sending a written request to the Office bearers.
- This membership, in no ways promises any additional benefits other than participation of group events.
- BinB membership is at the sole discretion of the BinB Office Bearers and BinB Core committee, and it is rendered on the basis of continuing support and active participation of the Individual & Family members. In the event of membership denial BinB Office Bearers or Core committee is not liable to provide an explanation.
- “Family” refers to the member, his/her spouse, Children (up to the age of 18 years), Parents, Parents in law, Siblings, as declared in the application form, at the time of becoming member / renewal of membership. The definition does not include any relationship yet to be formalized under the legal system of the Republic of India (example: Partners living together out of wedlock etc).
- Members are entitled to bring guests to the events only which are open to guests. Member need to inform office bearers upfront regarding this. The term “Guest” is defined as anyone who is a friend / part of the family of the member, residing outside of Bangalore.
- Our endeavor is to maintain an environment that is respectful, safe and dignified to every member of our Organization. Special attention for the same is given to the female members of Bengali in Bangalore. We encourage male members of the society to refrain from any action / behavior that could potentially affect the respect, security and dignity of the female members. It includes refraining from A. asking for “Restricted personal details” (Phone number, email / chat ID, local / permanent address), B. following / accompanying female members to their place of residence without their consent, C. Sending messages / contacting through any electronic medium without their consent and D. Sharing of “Restricted personal details” with any other member without prior approval of the person whose details are shared. Any “formal complaint” (a verbal / written complaint, accompanied by proof, if applicable) received by the office bearers (President, General Secretary & the Treasurer) from the female member / any of her family members regarding noncompliance to any of these points will result into immediate termination of the membership of the member (General / Executive) under scrutiny. It may also result into legal case under the judicial system of the Republic of India. Details of the complainant will be kept confidential.
- Any formal complaints against a member of the society is considered very seriously and subject to investigation by the office bearers. This may also result into termination of membership for the member under scrutiny found guilty.
- BinB believe in the Right To Information (RTI) to it's active members, and hence do encourage members to raise questions if they have any. All such requests shall be directly addressed by the Office Bearers of the Association. The turnaround time for any response is 60 working days from the day of sending the formal request through email or printed copy. A form is available with the General Secretary for filing such information requests.
- Members need to attend the periodic general meeting conducted by the association. An invitation will be sent to all members by the Office Bearers. The mode of communication shall be E-mail and social media (Facebook) page. Non-members who are interested to join BinB through paid membership shall also be allowed to participate in these meetings in order to get introduced with the association.
- Members shall play the role of an advisory body to the office bearers. They will assist the office bearers in ensuring that Bengali in Bangalore society is successful as an organization in its endeavors. However, the final decision making for all aspects shall be done by the Office bearers.
- Like any other organized associations in Bangalore, BinB also has a “Core committee” BinB member part of BinB Core committee is known as “BinB Core member”. Core members are expected to have the maximum responsibility when it comes planning way forward for BinB. “Office bearers (President, General secretary and Treasurer) are also a part of the Core committee group. This group is instrumental in driving the way BinB functions all through the year. All the decisions and planning pertaining to BinB is unitedly taken forward by the “Core committee” members.
- BinB members are allowed to be a general member of any number of other similar societies (and vice versa). However, BinB Core committee members are not entitled to be in the core committee of other similar Association.
